



CONTINUOUS ENROLLMENT - FAQs

*At Lakeway Christian Schools, we appreciate the opportunity to partner with you in the education of your student.
To more efficiently serve our families, we are eliminating the need to re-enroll each year.*

What is Re-Enrollment?

Re-enrollment is an annual data collection process that we use to update enrollment records of the current student body and plan for the following academic year. Until our families commit to returning each year, we can't make solid plans for staffing, programs, materials, curriculum, and facility usage. We take the stewardship of tuition dollars entrusted to us every year very seriously. We want to invest these tuition dollars wisely so that we can provide the best education possible for our students.

What is Continuous Enrollment? How is it different from the typical re-enrollment process?

Instead of an opt-in model, we are moving to an opt-out model. This year, parents will complete the re-enrollment process for one last time and sign up for continuous enrollment. This confirms your commitment to have your student continually enrolled at Lakeway until you notify us otherwise. Once your student is a part of continuous enrollment, you'll never have to go through the re-enrollment process again!

When will continuous enrollment start?

You will receive a personalized email from us inviting you to Re-enroll one last time with step-by-step instructions. If you re-enroll by February 29, 2020 then you will receive a 40% discount on your \$200 enrollment fee. Completing this process will secure your students spot for next year.

What will it cost?

Good news – we still want to offer our current families a discount when they are a part of continuous enrollment. If you re-enroll by February 29, 2020 then you will receive a 40% discount on your \$200 enrollment fee. Completing this process will secure your students spot for next year. In the future, your continuous enrollment fee will be automatically billed in two installments.

How do I sign up for this?

Your enrollment for the 2020-2021 school year will make your student continuously enrolled. Submit by the deadline listed above and take advantage of the discount.

If I sign up, am I committed until 12th grade?

No. While we would love to see your student obtain a diploma from LCA, we realize life situations come up and some- times a move is necessary. Each year you will have until January 31 to notify the admissions office if you are not planning to return. As long as notification is received in writing (i.e. email, letter, etc.) by January 31, you will not incur any enrollment fees. Exceptions to this may be made through the Headmaster to the LCS Board of Directors.

Once Continuous Enrollment starts, what is my responsibility?

Each year we will ask you to update your personal information so that we have current contact, medical and emergency information. This will be done through your Parent Portal.
